Aim of the call: to improve the impact of innovation policy by speeding up the take up of design as a user-driven innovation tool in national, regional and EU innovation policies, projects and support mechanisms by:


- 1. <u>mutual policy learning</u> and <u>international cooperation</u> testing transfer-ability of best practices ("learning by doing")
- 2. <u>mobilising</u> national, regional and European support providers <u>to</u> <u>reach an acceptance</u> of the <u>positive impact of design in innovation</u> <u>policies for the benefit of users</u> to mobilise necessary structural changes / adaptation and leverage budgets towards Design innovation support
- 3. <u>raising awareness of end-users</u> about the strategic role of design in innovation and business processes



Objectives of awarded projects

- to connect designers with relevant policy actors at national and regional level => give access to specialist support for users
- to bring together designers and innovative ecosystems (Living Labs) for exchange of methodologies and best practices
- to develop design metrics on value creation via design=>measuring economic impact of design
- to develop metrics on design innovation policies impact across Europe

- Process efficiency, product design, value chain optimisation
- Opportunities through more esthetical design of environmental products
